Current Situation:

- St. Johns County EOC is at Level 3 - Monitoring
- State EOC is at a Level 3 – Monitoring
- Federal Declaration of a National Emergency
- The Florida Governor has not issued an Executive Order
- All Government offices continue to operate at regular business hours.
- All Schools continue to operate on their regular schedule

County Actions:

- Emergency Operations Center is at a Level 3 – Monitoring
- St. Johns County has not Declared a Local State of Emergency
- No closures of any Government entities are anticipated at this time
- St. Johns County Health Department, BOCC, Administrator and appropriate staff have been briefed.
- Incident Command has been established with the St. Johns County Department of Health being the Incident Commander
- St. Johns County Health Department, Emergency Management, School Board and all other appropriate Agencies are participating in State Conference calls with the Florida Division of Emergency Management and Department of Health

- Assessing H1N1 vaccine allotment and prioritizing orders
